T ravel the endless plains of the world-famous Serengeti, search for the elusive Big 5 in the Ngorongoro Crater, join the Hadzabe Bush People as they go hunting & gathering, spot the tree climbing lions in <u>Lake Manyara</u> & enjoy the hospitality of a lodge & the romance of a tented camp in the heart of the Tanzanian bush on this 10-day adventure.

• Day 1: Arrival in Tanzania, Transfer to Hotel

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport or Arusha Airport you will be met by a Alkebulan Travels Transfer Driver and transferred to your lodge where the remainder of the day is at leisure – rest in your room, relax in the manicured gardens, enjoy a refreshing swim in the pool or explore Arusha and the surrounding areas on one of our day tours, the choice is yours. Meal Plan: Breakfast Only

• Day 2: Arusha - Tarangire National Park

Today you will drive to Tarangire for a full day game drive. One of Africa's little-known gems, it should be on the itinerary of all lovers of wilderness & solitude. The landscape is incredibly diverse with a mix that is not found anywhere else on the northern safari circuit; it is dotted with ancient baobab trees & large termite mounds & the Tarangire River is the only source of water during the dry season when the harsh sun suck the moisture from the landscape, baking the earth a dusty red while during the wet season you will experience dense bush & luscious high grasses. Famous for its large elephant population, it is also home to zebra, wildebeest, giraffe, waterbuck, baboons, & impala. Predators include lion, cheetah & leopard. The swamps are shared by flocks of birds; green wood hoopoes, lovebirds, tallish herons, white bellied go-away birds & giant kingfishers. On drier ground you will find the kori bustard & the heaviest of the flying birds; the ostrich. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Country Lodge Karatu

• Day 3: Lake Manyara National Park

Then After breakfast at the Lodge you will head north to Lake Manyara National Park. It's about 1 hour drive from the lodge. Lake Manyara National is at the foot of the Great Rift Valley. The park is famous for its tree-climbing lions and the vast elephant herds and large flock of aquatic migratory birds, more than 400 species of birds can be sported, as well as a unique features such as hot spring which is well known as Maji Moto' At the evening drive to the lodge for Dinner and Overnight

• Day 4: Lake Manyara - Lake Natron

Today you will travel to Lake Natron, wild & remote; it is situated at the base of Africa's only active volcano, Oldonyo Lengai, which is known as the Mountain of God to the local Maasai people. The area around Lake Natron contains some of the most harsh & amazing scenery in Africa & is utterly breathtaking for those clients who choose to travel off the beaten path. Together with your Guide, you will be accompanied by a local Maasai Guide & walk up to the Engero Sero Waterfalls. Winding up through the shady gorge you will reach a beautiful natural swimming pool surrounded by steep rock walls showered by cascading spring water where you will have the opportunity to swim. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Lake Natron Tented Camp

• Day 5: Full Day Lake Natron - Return to Karatu

Lake Natron is one of the most alkaline lakes in the world. Home to millions of tiny crustaceans, the lake is a haven for literally thousands of flamingos & it is one of the most important flamingo breeding grounds on earth. It is the landscape rather than the animals that is the attraction here & the area around the lake is dry, desolate & hauntingly beautiful. After breakfast you will walk out across the baked mud to the shores of the



great Soda Lake. From here, you can look back at the memorizing view of Oldoinyo Lengai standing tall amongst the rolling hills & flat plains. Its ash-grey color will remind you that this is still an active volcano. After lunch, you will travel back to Karatu where you will spend the night. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Bougainvillea safari Lodge

o Day 6: Karatu - Serengeti National Park

Today you will drive to the Serengeti National Park which is one of Africa's premier's game parks. Driving through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area toward the Serengeti National Park you will begin to experience the vastness of this territory and marvel at the multitude of animal and bird life while cruising through this acacia spotted savannah. You will visit a Maasai Village in the Ngorongoro Highlands (optional) where you will meet the Elders, Warriors, women and children and learn about the culture, beliefs and traditions of Tanzania's last nomadic tribe. The Serengeti is Tanzania's oldest and most popular national park and is also a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Serengeti is a year-round destination and each season has its own special highlight with the most famous being the annual wildebeest migration - a once in a lifetime experience. You will game drive enroute before arriving into the Serengeti in time for a half day game drive. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Serengeti KatiKati Tented Camp

• Day 7: Full Day in Serengeti National Park

Today, you will venture deeper into the world-famous Serengeti on a full day game drive. Enhance Your Safari: Hot Air Balloon Safari & Champagne Breakfast in the Serengeti National Park. Price: \$547 USD per person, subject to availability. Not suitable for children under 7 years of age. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Serengeti KatiKati Tented Camp

• Day 8: Full Day in Ngorongoro Crater

Today you will be rewarded with a full day game drive in the spectacular Ngorongoro Crater which became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1979. You will visit a Maasai Village in the Ngorongoro Highlands (optional) where you will meet the Elders, Warriors, women & children & learn about the culture, beliefs & traditions of Tanzania's last nomadic tribe. The Crater is famous for Africa's best game viewing as there is an ever present abundance of wildlife due to the permanent water supply on the crater floor. You will descend 610 meters into the Crater where your safari truly begins. Spot the endangered black rhino, wildebeest, buffalo, zebra, eland, Grant's & Thomson's gazelle & giant tusked elephants plus lions & leopards, cheetahs as well as scavengers such as spotted hyenas, jackals & wild dogs. Over 500 species of birds have been recorded within the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. In the late afternoon you will drive to the Lake Eyasi Safari Lodge where you will spend the night. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Lake Eyasi Safari Lodge

• Day 9: Full Day in Lake Eyasi

After breakfast you will meet your local guide and together you will meet the Hadzabe Bush People and Datoga Tribe. Join them as they go about their daily activities such as hunting and gathering. You will visit the area where they collect fruits and roots and find



water during the dry season as well as visit the caves they call home. In the afternoon you will return to your lodge where the remainder of the day is at leisure – swim in the pool which offers a refreshing respite from the dusty conditions, enjoy a cool drink at the bar or relax on your private balcony overlooking the lake. Meal Plan: Full Board Accommodation: Lake Eyasi Safari Lodge

• Day 10: Departure from Tanzania

Today you will be transferred to the airport for your onward flight. Upgrade Your Accommodation: This tour offers mid-range accommodation and upgrades to other midrange or luxury properties are available.
