Discover Nepal's unique heritage, natural wonders, epochal architecture, indigenous art along with the cultures and lifestyles. Nepal is perfect destination for aesthetes, who admire arts and are very sensitive to beauty. Pop in the must visit sights of Kathmandu valley - Pashupatinath Temple, Swayambunath, Boudhanath, Kathmandu Durbar Square, Nagarkot, Patan and Bhaktapur UNESCO world's heritage site respectively. Kathmandu city blends different culture and lifestyle practices in a single frame without any social and cultural disputes. Recognized as the "City of Temple" Kathmandu has dozens of temples, monuments and cultural sites in almost every nooks and cranny. The temples and palaces shrouded in medieval arts and architecture showcases the fine details of wood and metal carvings that are very eye pleasing. The incredible sunrise view over the Himalayan ranges from Nagarkot is something you cannot miss to see especially for those who cannot make time for Everest and Annapurna trek. Observe the glamorous view of Mt. Everest, Mt. Dhaulagiri and Annapurna ranges and be amazed by the natural wonders.

- **Itinerary:**
  - Day 1: **Kathmandu UNESCO World's heritage site**

Start a day after breakfast in a guided tour visiting to the ancient historical and spiritual sites in Kathmandu. Explore the four main attractions of Kathmandu valley enlisted in

UNESCO world heritage sites. Begins the trips making way to Kathmandu Durbar square; the heart of Kathmandu with dozens of religious temples. Look at the incredible creation of architecture carved in palaces, arts on wooden doors and windows. There are many religious sites to be explored such as kal bhairav temple, Ashok binayak temple, Shova bhagwati, Mahadev-Parbati temple and also the Kumari Ghar - home to living goddess. Next visit Pashupatinath temple, a sacred religious temple most important Hindu shrines dedicated to Lord shiva situated on the banks of Bagmati river. And then to Swayambhunath stupa, an oldest stupa of Nepal and also popularly known as Monkey temple. The monastery, statues and Harati temples are some other attraction of this place. Last destination of the day will be Boudhanath stupa, the largest stupa in the world where the Tibetan people preserved this cultural heritage site without disgraceful its artistic value. After learning more historical information return back to hotel. Spend night at hotel in Kathmandu.

◦ Day 2: **Drive to Nagarkot and Explore Patan and Bhaktapur Durbar square**

Early morning (5:00am) ride to Nagarkot for the best sunrise and the Himalayan views. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of green hills, terraced fields, lush forest together with the glimpse of Himalayas along the way. On reaching at the top hill, see the mesmerizing sunrise view over the mountain ranges. Also get to see the world's highest Mt. Everest and many others. After spending some memorable time head to the medieval city, Bhaktapur Durbar square. The Durbar square dates back to 15th century and has colossal pagoda temples and palaces with fine metal and wood carvings. Explore the main attraction of the palace complex includes 55 windows palace, Golden gate, Nyatopola temple, Lion's gate and Mini Pashupatinath temple. Stroll around the durbar square and get a peek into the everyday struggle of the people living around the area. Make way to the ancient city, Patan Durbar Square the home to finest collection of temple and palaces within charming sculpt in the Nepal. Immerse yourself into the deep cultures and tradition of Newar people and explore the old age beautiful temple some of which are lord Krishna temple, golden temple, Vishwanath temple and monasteries, museum, palaces carved with fragile art and murals. After the exploration you will be transferred to your hotel.
