Day 1: Hopefully, your flight is scheduled for an early landing in Entebbe. Your guide/driver will pick you from Entebbe Airport and head out for Murchison falls. The highlights of this park include; the roaring rapids of the Murchison, the rolling plains of Uganda's largest National Park where you will have the chance of viewing lions, giraffes, hartebeest, buffalo, and elephants. Then surely you will be fascinated by the concentration of hippos and the Nile crocodiles here. For birders, Murchison Falls boasts 450 bird species including the elusive shoebill stork, dwarf king fisher, the white-thigh hornbill, and the Goliath heron among others. En route, make a stopover at Zziwa Rhino sanctuary for your first Big 5 experience where you will have an hour of rhino tracking. Another stop will be in Masindi in order to enjoy your lunch. #### • Day 2: Murchison game drive and boat trip to the base of the falls

Day 2: After an early breakfast, tour the Northern section of Murchison with a high concentration of savannah wildlife. Enjoy game viewing and photography of elephants, buffalos, waterbucks, giraffes, Uganda kobs and lions, the leopards (if you are lucky) plus a variety of bird species. Return to your accommodation for lunch then go for the boat trip to the base of the falls. This trip is said to be the highlight of the safari in Murchison falls since it allows you to get up close to the animal species within the water. Cruise past huge hippo pods, crocodiles, bathing buffalo, and numerous aquatic birds adorning the north bank on the way to the mighty waterfalls. You will have an opportunity to take thousands of pictures (and so carry your camera with you if you like). Also, proceed for a hike (if you like) to the top of the falls. The hike is a strenuous one but the thrill on reaching the top is unforgettable. Miss it only if you must! Return to your accommodation thereafter. Free cancellation up to 5 day(s) prior departure, Or traveler will pay 50 % of the tour amount

Cancellation & Refund In the event that you need to cancel your tour, you must submit your cancellation request in writing. Charges will be calculated from the date we receive your written cancellation. All payments for travel services not provided to the passenger shall be refunded in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and in accordance with Aventyr Africa Safaris cancellation policy: The cancellation fee will be calculated as follows: No less than 45 days prior to scheduled departure date: 10% of the full payment per person. 45 to 15 days prior to scheduled departure date: 20% of the full payment per person. 14 to 7 days prior to scheduled departure date: 50% of the full payment per person. 6 to 0 days prior to scheduled departure date: 100% of the full payment per person. Plus: additional cancellation fees, if applicable, imposed by the service providers other than Aventyr Africa Safaris (may include but not limit to banks or other payment platforms, airlines, hotels etc.) will be deducted from the money refunded. Traveler substitutions are considered as cancellations of reservations and are subject to theabove cancellation fees. After the tour has commenced, we are unable to refund any amount for unused services (may include but not limit to hotels, air or train tickets, meals, admission fees) due to your early departure, late arrival, or missed days on tours. Cancellation by Aventyr Africa Safaris The company reserves the right to cancel the event or any part of it for any of the following reasons: â€" If the company or its supplier(s) regard adverse weather conditions or other safety concerns as unacceptable and which cannot reasonably be overcome. â€" If the company reasonably believes that you may cause harm or damage to its reputation or to the reputation of its suppliers or to property belonging to its suppliers. â€" If a company supplier or suppliers is/are unable to host the event for any reason. â€" If changes you wish to make to the booking mean it is uneconomical or impractical to hold the event. Should the company cancel an event, it shall be rescheduled for a mutually convenient date, or a refund shall be provided to the client. Cancellation by client(s) The cancellation of a booking by the client must be made in writing and signed from the group head. Alterations made by Client(s) The company shall try to accommodate any reasonable changes the client wishes to make to the event. These changes shall not be deemed accepted until confirmed in writing by the company.
