Pick up from Bandaranaike International Airport by the Beauty travels representative for a comfortable drive to Sigiriya. The ancient city, SIGIRIYA is renowned for its 5thcenturyy frescoes and has been declared by UNESCO as the 8th Wonder of the World. The ruins of the capital built by King Kassapa, the Sigiriya Rock Fortress, lie from the steep slopes all the way to the granite peak at an elevation of 180m. Known as the 'Lion's Rock', aptly named owing to its architecture. A series of galleries and staircases emerging from the mouth of a gigantic lion, man-made by bricks and plaster is the access to the summit. Stop at the PINNAWELA ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE on the way, to witness the magnificent Asian elephants bathing and frolicking in the river nearby. It is the home and breeding ground for abandoned and injured elephants, looked after by caretakers. Visit historical and religious sights such as Dambulla Cave Temple housing 80 ancient caves and enjoy the thrilling experience of climbing 1,200 steps that lead to the top of the SIGIRIYA ROCK FORTRESS, the Water Garden, Frescoes, Mirror Wall, and Lions Paw surrounding it. FAQs

Visa requirements:

www.eta.gov.lk the visa will initially be limited to 30 days from the date of arrival and which may extend to six months by contacting the Department of Immigration and Emigration. This process will not be applicable for Singapore and Maldives passport holders as they are granted visas on arrival.

Climate and seasons:

In the Low Lands, the Climate is in general tropical with an average temperature of about 27°C in Colombo. In the Higher elevations, however, it can be quite cold with temperatures going down to 16°C. Bright and Sunny days are the norm and are common even during the height of the Monsoon – climatically Sri Lanka has no offseason. The southwest monsoon brings rain mainly from May to July to the western, southern and central regions of the island. While the northeast monsoon rains occur in the northern and eastern areas in December and January.
