- **Tour Introduction:**

7 Days Ultimate Uganda safari is one of the best wildlife and primate safari packages to undertake during a tour to explore Uganda the Pearl of Africa. These 7 days Ultimate Uganda safari is mainly a wildlife, chimpanzee tracking, and gorilla trekking experience trip. It provides you with a great chance to engage in a diversity of wildlife activities ranging from chimp tracking, gorilla trekking, game drives, launch cruise, and Batwa cultural experience.

The 7 days Ultimate Uganda safari (1-week safari in Uganda), wildlife, chimpanzees, and gorilla trekking ushers you into 3 different safari parks in Uganda including Kibale Forest National Park a home to 13 primate species, Queen Elizabeth National Park which hosts the unique tree climbing lions and Bwindi Impenetrable National Park with over 459 endangered mountain gorillas. Your 7 days Uganda safari, wildlife, chimpanzees, and gorilla trekking trip begins and ends in Kampala or Entebbe.

- **Itinerary:**

- Day 1: **Departure for Kibale Forest National Park via Fort Portal Tourism City**

Pick up early in the morning by your driver guide and you transfer to Kibale Forest National Park after a leisurely breakfast. Take 5-6 hours driving via Mubende to Fort Portal where you will have a lunch break then connect to the lodge in Kibale Forest National Park. Accommodation • Luxury: Papaya Lake Lodge, Kyaninga Lodge • Mid-range: Primate Lodge (Moderate) • Budget: Chimpanzee Guesthouse, Kibale Forest Camp (Basic)

- **Day 2: Chimpanzee tracking in Kibale Forest & nature walk in Bigodi Swamp**

Go track chimpanzees after a hefty breakfast and briefing at Kanyanchu Tourist Centre, taking you from 2-4 hours. The actual chimp trek starts at 8:00 am with a park guide on lead and you will have a maximum of 1 hour enjoying a face-to-face encounter with chimpanzees. Thereafter, walk back or your driver guide will pick you up and then transfer you for a lunch break in your lodge. Later at 2:00 pm, go enjoy a nature walk with a community guide on the lead as he or she ushers you into Bigodi Wetland Sanctuary. Explore a variety of primates, birds, and flora that you didn't sight while in Kibale Forest trekking chimpanzees. - **Day 3: Leave Kibale for Queen Elizabeth National Park through Fort Portal**

Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and later, depart for Queen Elizabeth National Park, 3 hour drive through Fort Portal Tourism City. Lunch will be offered at the lodge and later, you embark on an afternoon launch trip on Kazinga Channel. Get to see submerged hippos, basking crocodiles, diverse water birds, and a lot more. Accommodation • Luxury: Katara Lodge, Ishasha Wilderness Camp, Mweya Safari Lodge • Mid-range: Park View Lodge, Kyambura Gorge Lodge • Budget: Bush Lodge, Simba Safari Camp, Mweya Hostel

- **Day 4: Game drive and boat or launch cruise**

Have breakfast and after, the game drive taking you 2-3 hours on Kasenye plains will begin with an experienced guide. Get to enjoy sights of buffaloes, lions, African bush elephants, antelopes, leopards, warthogs, and birds to mention but a few. Drive back in a 4x4 Land Cruiser or 4x4 Safari Van with a pop-up roof to have lunch in your lodge then go for yet another thrilling launch cruise on Kazinga Channel. - **Day 5: Game drive & take 3 hour's drive to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park**

Get up early and have a leisurely breakfast. Later, head to Bwindi in 3 hours but expect a quick game drive at Ishasha sector, south of Queen Elizabeth National Park. This lets you see the tree-climbing lions and you will have lunch at Savanna Resort before checking into the lodge in Bwindi. Accommodation • Luxury: Chameleon Hill Lodge, Gorilla Forest Camp, Buhoma Lodge • Mid-range: Ichumbi Lodge, Gorilla Mist Camp, Silverback Lodge • Budget: Ichumbi Gorilla Lodge, Nshongi Camp

- **Day 6: Gorilla trekking & Batwa cultural experience**

After a leisurely breakfast, head to the Bwindi offices with some snacks and a bottle of mineral water to be briefed on guidelines for gorilla trekking. At 8:00 am, start a search for any one of the 20 gorilla families assigned to you in your group of 8 visitors. This may last you 2-6 hours and it includes a maximum of 1 hour of photo taking and learning more about mountain gorillas. Get back to have a relaxed afternoon then go interact with the Batwa pygmies in their communities. They will entertain you with their great dances

and music performances as you also explore in-depth about their traditions and cultures.

After breakfast, get to your 4x4 safari Land Cruiser or 4x4 Safari van ready for the return trip to Kampala or Entebbe. Make a stop at Igongo for a delicious lunch break. Later continue with the drive and have a stop at the equator line in Kayabwe where you relax and take pictures. End of Your 7 Days Ultimate Uganda Safari
