◦ **Day 1: Day One : Bandaranaike International Airport - Sigiriya / Dambulla**

Pick up from Bandaranaike International Airport by the Beauty travels representative for a comfortable drive to Sigiriya/ Dambulla The ancient city, SIGIRIYA is renowned for its 5th-century frescoes and has been declared by UNESCO as the 8th Wonder of the World. The ruins of the capital built by King Kassapa, the Sigiriya Rock Fortress, lie from the steep slopes all the way to the granite peak at an elevation of 180m. Known as the 'Lion's Rock', aptly named owing to its architecture. A series of galleries and staircases emerging from the mouth of a gigantic lion, man-made by bricks and plaster is the access to the summit. Visit the historical and religious sight, Dambulla Cave Temple housing 80 ancient caves and towering over 160m over the surrounding plains. Check in to the hotel to freshen up and unwind Join us in the evening for an exciting 4x4 Jeep Safari at MINNARIYA/ KAUDULLA/ HURULU NATIONAL PARK and witness the largest elephant gathering in the world. As many as 300 elephants gather around the ancient Minneriya water tank to take advantage of the receding waters. Check in to the hotel for a well-deserved rest for the night. ◦ **Day 2: Day Two : Sigiriya - Kandy**

Stop on the way at the SRI MUTHUMARIAMMAN TEMPLE, Matale. It is a popular Hindu shrine dedicated to Mariamman, the goddess of rain and fertility, located in the middle of the town. The history of this temple can be traced back to the 19th century. The next is a visit to the GEM MUSEUM AND WORKSHOP to understand the marvelous process of gemstones being transformed from the mine to market in different stages. Check in to the hotel in Kandy, to freshen up and unwind. Get ready in the evening for the KANDY CITY TOUR including a visit to Sri Dalada Maligawa, the TEMPLE OF THE TOOTH RELIC, the most sacred Buddhist temple in Sri Lanka with rich architecture. Fire and harvest dances accompanied by ceremonial drums rising and falling to the lively tempo. ◦ **Day 3: Day Three : Kandy - Nuwara Eliya**

First stop is the PERADENIYA ROYAL BOTANICAL GARDENS, the oldest formal garden in Sri Lanka. Located 460m above sea level it houses more than 4000 species of plants, including orchids, spices, medicinal plants and palm trees. En-route, visit a Tea Factory and TEA PLANTATION in Nuwara Eliya, and enjoy a tour of the process that goes into brewing that perfect cuppa tea. The next stop is SRI BHAKTA HANUMAN TEMPLE. It is one of the important Hindu Temples in the country located on the summit of a beautiful picturesque mountain in Ramboda. You will be marveled at the site of the 18 feet Hanuman, the tallest statue in Sri Lanka. The RAMBODA FALLS located close by is known for breathtaking landscapes, ridges, streams and hilly mountains at an elevation of 358ft. Check in to your hotel to rest till the evening. Hop onboard to go on a sightseeing tour of Nuwara Eliya including NUWARA ELIYA TOWN, MARKET PLACE, GOLF COURSE and LAKE GREGORY. With over 215 species of birds and 44 diverse mammals, If you're lucky you will be awestruck with a sighting of a leopard, an experience you will never forget. FAQs

Visa requirements:

www.eta.gov.lk the visa will initially be limited to 30 days from the date of arrival and which may extend to six months by contacting the Department of Immigration and Emigration. This process will not be applicable for Singapore and Maldives passport holders as they are granted visas on arrival.

Climate and seasons:

In the Low Lands, the Climate is in general tropical with an average temperature of about 27°C in Colombo. In the Higher elevations, however, it can be quite cold with temperatures going down to 16°C. Bright and Sunny days are the norm and are common even during the height of the Monsoon – climatically Sri Lanka has no offseason. The southwest monsoon brings rain mainly from May to July to the western, southern and central regions of the island. While the northeast monsoon rains occur in the northern and eastern areas in December and January.
