The trek offers tremendous trekking, exploring, and picturesque scenery; from lowland local settlements and terraced farmlands to alpine white glaciers. Whereas, Chitwan is a very popular destination for easily accessible terrain and the wildlife, herbs, and vegetations, etc. at the Chitwan National Park.

• Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu (1,300m/4,264ft)

Highlights and activities: Tribhuvan International Airport, Evening Walk at Thamel Places Included: Kathmandu, Tribhuvan International Airport, Thamel

• Day 2: Kathmandu: Sightseeing and Trek Preparation

Highlights and activities: Sightseeing at Kathmandu, UNESCO World Heritage Sites, Introduction with group members and trekking crew, Equipment checking, and briefing about the trek Duration: Half Day Places Included: Thamel, Kathmandu Durbar Square, Boudhanath, Pashupatinath

• Day 3: Kathmandu to Pokhara(830m) by flight

• Day 4: Pokhara – Nayapul - Tikhedhunga (1,540 m/ 5,052 ft)

Day 10: Deurali to Annapurana Base Camp (4,130m/13,545ft) via Machhapuchhre Base Camp (3700m/12135ft)

Highlights and activities: High Altitude Walk, Avalanche Area, Wild animals like Mountain Goats, Marine Glacier, Annapurna - I View, Machhapuchhre View, Snow Bowl, Waterfall, Landscape, Sunset View Duration: 12Km (5-6hrs) Places Included: Deurali, Bagar, Machhapuchhre Base Camp, Annapurna Base Camp

• Day 11: Annapurna Base Camp to Bamboo
