• Tour Introduction:

Hoi An Ancient Town is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a South-East Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its buildings and its street plan reflect the influences, both indigenous and foreign, that have combined to produce this unique heritage site.

• Itinerary:

• Day 1: Da Nang- Son Tra Peninsula

Your first day will be driven by ABM Travel to Son Tra Peninsula. Son Tra Peninsula is 10km from the center of Da Nang City to the northeast. It is one of the stunning destinations of Da nang City where still remain more than 30km² of natural forests, nearly 300 types of plants, and several hundred kinds of fauna, including rare animals. A 693 m high mountain range of Monkey mountain and white sandy beaches make the peninsula to be a perfect picture made by Nature Mother.

o Day 2: Da Nang- Hoi An- Da Nang

The second will be headed to Hoi An, The UNESCO site of the World. Hoi An Ancient town is located in Viet Nam's central Quang Nam Province, on the north bank near the mouth of the Thu Bon River. The inscribed property comprises 30 ha and it has a buffer zone of 280 ha. It is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a small-scale trading port active in the 15th to 19th centuries which traded widely, both with the countries of Southeast and East Asia and with the rest of the world. Its decline in the later 19th century ensured that it has retained its traditional urban tissue to a remarkable degree.

• Day 3: Da Nang- Than Tai Mountain

Than Tai Mountain, Hot Springs Park is an oasis within the mountains that is worth your visit. ABM Travel will drive you to the majestic landscape and fantastic atmosphere of the hot spring. You will have a chance to soak yourselves in the mineral water which is exploited from underground water in the Dragon Acupuncture Lake. After enjoying a great time in the hot mineral bath, spice up your day with exciting games in a nearby



waterpark including a wave pool, kid's pool, adventure slide, and rainbow slide.

o Day 4: Da Nang- Dragon Bridge

Dragon Bridge is one of the attractive destinations for young people who love to share their stunning photos on their social media. It started to build in 2009, by the Vietnamese government. It crosses Han River which is the largest river in Da Nang. The bridge is shaped like a Dragon crossing the river.
