- **Day 1: Arrive In Lhasa**

- **Day 2: Sightseeing tour in Lhasa**

Especially Potala palace is for winter palace of Dalai Lama which is located in Red hill. From Potala palace, witness the amazing scenery of the entire Lhasa city. It remains constantly bustling with religious worshiper's .after the Potala Palace in the afternoon you will be guided to Jokhang Temple which offers the first glimpse of devout Tibetans. Next, you will guide Bharkhor Street. You will find ancient Art and architecture as well as you can taste local food and tea with the typical house. Overnight at the hotel.

- **Day 3: Second Day in Sightseeing tour in Lhasa**

- The days start as you will be guided for Drepung Monastery and Sera Monastery which is one of the great three Gelug monasteries of Tibet. In the afternoon you will guide for Sera Monastery another one of the Great Gelug Monasteries of Tibet, also a best-preserved monastery in Tibet within its whitewashed walls and golden roofs. After lunch, we visit Norbulingka, a summer palace of the Dalai Lama, the typical park is worth appreciating the stunning scenery on the highland and admiring the palace buildings over 200 years old. After visiting those places you will back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

- **Day 4: Lhasa to Ganden Monastery**

- The place you will be exploring today is Ganden Monastery (Ganden Namgyan Ling), one of Tibet's three great and pristine Gelug university monasteries. As you drive you will be able to enjoy views of the beautiful Kyichu River (Lhasa River). As well you can see the spectacular monastery located peacefully on the mountain top. Then, visit the Genden Monastery chapels. Later, visit the tomb of the Gelupa founder, Tsongkhapa. After exploration of Ganden Monastery, you will be guided towards Tibetan farmers villages to get to know their life better. Overnight at Hotel.
