Agra Fort Take a guided tour of Agra fort, It's a historical fort in the city of Agra. It was the main residence of the emperors of the Mughal Dynasty until 1638. Itmad-ud-Daula It's a Mughal mausoleum in the city of Agra. • Day 3: Jaipur To Delhi

After Breakfast drive to Amber Fort situated on the top of the hill. Amber Fort is located in Amer. It was built by Raja Man Singh I. It is known for its artistic elements. The Maota Lake located in front of the monument acts as a source of water for the fort. Jal Mahal Jal Mahal is a palace in the middle of the Man Sagar Lake in Jaipur city, the capital of the state of Rajasthan, India. The palace and the lake around it were renovated and enlarged in the 18th century by Maharaja Jai Singh II of Amber. City Palace of Jaipur The City Palace, Jaipur was established at the same time as the city of Jaipur, by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, who moved his court to Jaipur from Amber, in 1727 Jantar Mantar Jaipur The Jantar Mantar is a collection of nineteen architectural astronomical instruments built by the Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh II, the founder of Jaipur, Rajasthan. The monument was completed in 1734. It features the world's largest stone sundial, and is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Hawa Mahal Palace of Wind Hawa Mahal is a palace in Jaipur, India. Made with the red and pink sandstone, the palace sits on the edge of the City Palace, Jaipur, and extends to the Zenana, or women's chambers. The structure was built in 1799 by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh, the grandson of Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, who was the founder of Jaipur. After visiting place take you delhi back in hotel or airport Note:. Please make sure that every Friday taj mahal closed so make sure that on next day should not be friday otherwise first day we can do Agra and last day Delhi will manage
