• Day 1: **Delhi**

Company representatives will pick you up from the hotel or another central location in Delhi. o Day 2: **Delhi**

• Day 4: : Jaipur via Fathepur sikri

Visit the symbol of love Taj Mahal with the guide at down. After breakfast, travel to the Pink City Jaipur. On the way you will stop in Fathepur Sikri and do sightseeing of the Royal and Sacral part of the city. After it, further journey to Jaipur. Check in the hotel. Local sightseeing of Jaipur. • Day 5: Jaipur

• Day 6: Jaipur -Jodhpur

It is a very strenuous work to climb on the hilltop but you can also get there by cable car in 10 minutes. After that you will be taken by car to Delhi and dropped off.
