Sightseeing Tour of Kathmandu valley can be done all time of the year. However Spring (March, April, May) and Autumn (September, October, November) are the best months. The air, freshly washed by the monsoon rain, is crystal clear, stunning mountain scenery, and the weather is still comfortably warm. In the winter the cold can be bitter, The temperature is about 5 degrees in Kathmandu.

In Monsoon the Heritage sites and roads can be wet due to the monsoon rain and you may have to travel all day under the rain. But with care, traveling is possible and there are certainly fewer Travellers on the famous sites.
