• Tour Highlights:

Our tour will begin by Kanheri Caves passing through the green forests of the Sanjay Gandhi National Park. Located 3.5 miles (6 km) inside the park, Explore Buddhist sculptures and relief carvings, paintings and inscriptions, dating from the 1st century BCE to the 10th century CE. The cave complex comprises one hundred and nine caves, carved from the basalt rock. Most of the caves are used as the Buddhist viharas, meant for living, studying, and meditating. Don't miss the Buddhist shrine, called a stupa, in one of the caves before returning to Mumbai.

• Tour Introduction:

The Kanheri Caves, a set of hand-cut Buddhist rock sculptures, are one of Mumbai's top attractions. But the remote location—on an island within Sanjay Gandhi National Park—can put many travelers off. Get a first-hand peek at the 109 carvings, some dating from the 1st century BC, with this convenient and hasslefree private tour, which puts the world-famous heritage site at your fingertips.
