• Day 1: Airport - Pinnawala - Dambulla

Arrival in Sri Lanka. You will be met by agents and transferred to Dambulla. (Travel time approximately: 05 hours) Access the road * Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage - Application. An orphanage was established in 1975 for abandoned and injured elephants in Pinnawala, 55 miles from Colombo, on the Thin, Colombo-Kandy road. The number of elephants has now exceeded 65. As a result of the slave breeding program, elephants were brought from different parts of the country and 23 newborns. The best time to visit is from 09:30-10:00 hours to 13:30-14:00 hours and the bathing time is from 10:00-10:30 hours. And 14:00-14:30 hours. When all the elephants are taken to the river. Proceed to Dambulla: Arrive At the hotel and check in. Sigiriya is a "World Heritage Site" and a 5th-century "Fortress of the Sky" and is one of the island's most amazing wonders. It is also known as Lion Rock because of the large lion that stood at the entrance to the palace at



the top of the 600-foot-high rock. At its summit, the foundations of the Royal Palace, water tanks for water supply, and all other buildings and watchtowers are on the edge. The only ancient work of Sinhala secular paintings on one of the stairs is still surviving in the form of 21 living Damascus murals. Not to be missed are the water parks, fountain gardens, summer houses, boulder gardens, and caves in the enclosed area.

• Day 2: Sigiriya

Hotel Breakfast * Dambulla Cave Temple - Dambulla Cave is an isolated rock mass 500 feet high and about a mile around the base. of the first century. During his 14 years of exile from Anuradhapura, Dambulla Guha provided protection to King Walagamba. When he regained the throne, he built some of the finest stone temples on the island. The first cave has an image of the Buddha carved from a 47 feet long rock. Images of gods associated with Buddhism are everywhere. The murals on the walls and ceiling are the oldest ones here, but they were painted during the Kandyan period. In the second cave, there are 150 living statues of the Buddha in various poses, some of the best and largest, with statues of gods and kings. The ceiling is covered with murals which depict the great events of the life of the Buddha and important landmarks in the history of the Sinhalese people. (It takes 1 & 1/2 hours to get up and polite for a picnic) Overnight stay at a hotel in Dambulla.

• Day 3: Dambulla - Kandy

Breakfast at the hotel - This morning you will be transferred to Kandy (Tourist time approx: 03 hours) * Visit the Peradeniya Royal Botanic Gardens (excursion takes about 2 hours) - 147 acres; It was started in 1374 as an amusement park for the kings of Gampola and Kandy. There are more than 4,000 species of trees, plants and spots. Some rare and endemic as well as tropical plants are found in gardens. Spice Garden and Orchid House are popular with tourists. There are five palm paths to beautify the gardens, the oldest and tallest Palm Avenue (Royal Palm Avenue) was planted in 1905, and Double Coconut from the Seychelles Island is one such path with the largest seed of all the plants in the world. Gem Gallery visit, Evening attend the Colorful Kandy Cultural Show * AD Since the 4th century, when the sacred tooth relics were brought to Sri Lanka, the relics' glory and holiness grew, hidden in the sacred hands of Princess Orissa's hair. In Sri Lanka and throughout the Buddhist world. It is considered to be the most valuable resource in Sri Lanka. Spend the night at a hotel in Kandy.

• Day 4: Kandy - Colombo

Hotel Breakfast Go to Colombo for City & Shopping (Travel time approximately: 03 and 1/2 hours) * Colombo - Across the city you will be taken to busy commercial areas as well as wooded accommodation. , Cinnamon Gardens. View Fort, former British Administrative Center and Military Fortress, Goldsmith's official residence in the heart of Sea Street - Pita, the Bazaar area, the stone carvings of a Hindu temple, and the 1749 old Dutch Wolfendale Church. Visit BMICH, see the image of Aukana Buddha and Independence Square. * Shopping in Colombo Tour * Odel Unlimited offers the whole family not only shopping for designer apparel, but also the taste buds of a voyage of discovery. Spend the night at a hotel in Colombo.
