- **Tour Introduction:**

Nyerere National Park(formally Selous game reserve), Africa's largest game reserve and one of the favourite game viewing areas in Africa continent covering an area of 54,000 square kilometers comprise of a vast wilderness with forest, grassy,mountains and open woodlands. This reserve was named after Frederick Selous who was great Hunter and explorer and relatively undisturbed by human impact. Today the boundaries of this Nyerere National Park are being properly established but according to source it is believed that this park will encompass

the photographic sector in the northern part of the reserve and stretch out all the way to the wilderness areas of River Rufiji to the south. The beauty of the park is matched by the quality of a safari here; boating, walking, fly camping complement standard game driving in thriving wildlife areas. This is an outrageously good safari park and essential component of any southern circuit itinerary.

- **Itinerary:**

- **Day 1: Dar es salaam ----- Nyerere National Park(Selous)**

- Meet and pick up at 07:30am, drive to Nyerere National Park (formally the Selous game reserve) about 220kms which takes approx. 4 hours. Upon your arrival in Selous Ngalawa Campsite/Ngalawa Tented Camp, a quick prepared hot lunch with our chef, rest a little bit and wondering the forest around the camp with different species and monkeys. And at 16:00am going on Boat safari with skipper/guide through mighty Rufiji river watching Hippos, crocodiles, elephants and other animals which drift here for a water drink till sunset, dinner and overnight at Selous Ngalawa campsite/Selous Ngalawa Tented Camp. Meals plan: (Lunch/Dinner).

- **Day 2: Nyerere National Park full day**

- After breakfast at 07:00am going for the full day game drive with you packed lunch, plentiful plan game drives and observing abundance of wildlife such as wild dogs, Buffalos, waterbucks, Kudus, Impalas, giraffes, zebras, lions, and etc. till sunset, dinner and overnight at Selous Ngalawa Campsite/Selous Ngalawa Tented Camp. (Meals plan: Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner).

- **Day 3: Another full day Nyerere National Park**

- After breakfast 06:30am going for a full day game drive with packed lunch, served at the picnic site and proceed with the game drive till the sunset to explore about the animals as you drive along side of Rufiji river and others inner areas. Dinner and overnight at Selous Ngalawa Campsite/Selous Ngalawa Tented Camp. Meals Plan: (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

- **Day 4: Walking safari and Mloka cultural tour**

- Pre-breakfast walking safari with an armed ranger 06:30am and bushman for 2 hours only this a touch with nature in different style, then back to the camp at 08:30am for full breakfast rest wondering and walking watching primate including the yellow baboons, blue monkeys, velvet monkeys etc, and birds as well. Take hot lunch and proceed with Mloka village tour to explore more about the Ndengereko tribe traditional and cultures, dancing fishing methods and back to Selous Ngalawa Campsite/Selous Ngalawa Tented Camp. Meals Plan: (full breakfast Lunch and Dinner).

- **Day 5: Nyerere National Park ----- Dar es salaam**

- After your breakfast at 08:30am leisure drive back to Dar es Salaam with packed lunch via villages along the way sightseeing via several villages on the way, depends on the location of drop-off; that is to Airport/Hotel or Ferry terminal to Zanzibar. End of the trip
